NATIONAL LEVEL SYMPOSIUM - Report 2019-2020

The Research Development Cell of St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science, Cuddalore and Patent Information Centre of Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology (TNSCST) jointly organized a two days National level Symposium on the topic "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) - Bridging Academia & Industry" on 6th and 7th of January 2020 at St. Joseph's College, Cuddalore.

The Symposium was inaugurated by Dr. R. Srinivasan, Member Secretary, TNSCST, Chennai in the presence of Rev. Fr. G. Peter Rajendiram, Secretary of the College and Dr. M. Arumai Selvam, Principal of the College. The Member Secretary of the State Council said in his inaugural address that students and faculty must focus on innovative research leading to patentable inventions. He also stressed the importance of Reinvention as a possibility of increasing patents. The State Government has a target of 500 patents a year, he further added. The Patent Information Centre of the Council is ready to help researchers in getting patents and anyone with new ideas and products can approach the council he said. Rev. Fr. G. Peter Rajendiram, Secretary of the College, said the college is ready to coordinate the colleges and institutions in Cuddalore District and nearby districts in IPR related issues. Shri. Muthukumaran Devarajan, Senior Strategist - IP & Competitive Intelligence, GE India Technology Centre, Bangalore, Shri. P. Balamurugan, Deputy Controller of Patents & Design, Patent Office, Chennai, Ms. T Sahila, Project Scientist, Patent Information Centre – TNSCST, Chennai, Dr. Rishikesan Sankaranarayanan, Business Development Director, Lifex Biolabs Inc., CA-USA, Singapore and Mrs. R. Sindhuja, Examiner of Trade Marks, Trade Mark Registry, Chennai delivered lectures on the first day.


Dr. U. P. Senthil Kumar, Senior Vice-President, Research and Development Centre, Orchid Pharma Ltd., Chennai, Ms. Preethi Narayanan, Patent Consultant, Chennai and Dr. I. Geetha, Senior Technical Officer, ICMR – Vector Control Research Centre, Puducherry spoke on the applied aspects of IPR on the second day. Dr. Balanehru Subramanian, Director,

CIDRF, Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Puducherry delivered the valedictory address and highlighted the importance of copyrights. He asked the student community to work on novel ideas so that they can be patented. Dr. J. Jon Arokiaraj, the Vice-Principal and Rev. Fr. A. Alex, Dean of Studies of the college also spoke during the valedictory function.

Around two hundred and fifty participants including students, research scholars and teaching faculty from academia and members from industries attended the symposium. Booklet on IPR published by the TNSCST was distributed to all the participants. Under the guidance of Dr. Joseph C. Daniel, Coordinator, Research Development Cell and Head, Department of Microbiology of St. Joseph's College, Dr. D. Sumitha, Dr. I. Benjamin Franklin, Prof. Paul Arokiadoss and Dr. D. Daniel said series of workshops and seminars will be conducted on IPR related topics for the benefit of students and academic faculty through the Research Development Cell of St. Joseph's College in the near future.

















About the College

St. Joseph's College is a legacy of the 19th century, handed down to the present management by the venerable Fathers of the Society of the Foreign Mission of Paris. The college was inaugurated on 11th October 1991. The College obtained Recognition u/s 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 on 4th November 2004, Permanent Affiliation on 7th March 2008, Autonomous Status on 17th June 2008 and 12(B) Status by the University Grants Commission on 28th August 2015. The instruments available include FTIR-Spectrometer system ALPHA (Bruker, Germany) and SpectraMax Plus384 UV/Visible High-throughput Microplate Spectrophotometer (Molecular Devices, USA). The cell promotes interdisciplinary research among the Departments of the college and with other Universities/colleges within and outside the country.
