MINUTES OF THE SEVENTEENTH MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

Date: 02-09-2022 Time: 11.00 a.m.

The Seventeenth Meeting of the Academic Council was held at 11.00 a.m. on Friday, 02nd September 2022 in the Library Annex Seminar Hall.

The members of the academic council were present and Rev. Fr. Dr. R. Joseph Raj was excused due to personal reasons. The meeting started with the invocation by Dr. J. Jon Arockiaraj, Vice-Principal.

Dr. M. Arumai Selvam, Principal requested the members to observe a minute of silence in memory of Dr. S. Joseph Christian Daniel, Head, PG and Research Department of Microbiology and IQAC Coordinator, who passed away on 10-08-2022.
