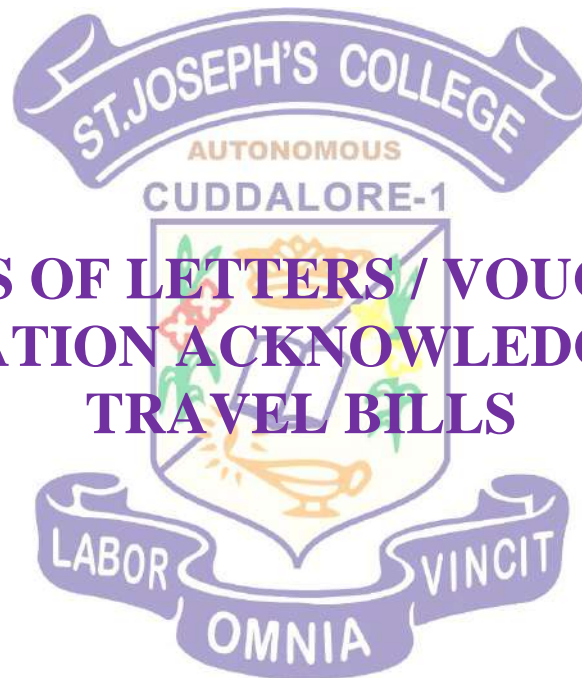

About the Programme

Education is the foundation of human social structure for survival, growth, and sustenance. For the custodians and the delivery networks, the understanding of the needs of education evolves with time. If at one point it is about being relevant to the current social, economic, political, technological, and environmental matrices then at another time, it is about deep diving to develop a plausible and reimagined future scenario, constituting of the spatial structure, organisation and institution structures, the collective consciousness and related priorities and preparedness required to address the needs and sustainability of the future state.

The main challenges for the leaders of academic institutions of advance education in their day-to-day life is about managing transition in a dynamic world by maintaining a balance of the fiery trigon of accountabilities of education, namely (a) for social measure, education as a social equalizer for minorities and economically weaker section of the society, (b) for the board of trustees by meeting the standards of measure based on the competitive indicators of the education sector, and (c) for the students, institution's traction with the employers, and relevance of the programmes they graduate to the jobs and performance, and future proofing of social and economic sustenance.

To oar through the white waters of the trigon of accountabilities of education, the leaders of advance education may consider a reciprocal method (constructivist method) of engaging multidisciplinary individuals and people of multidimensional worldviews in a team to ideate for options of a framework of an education system for effectively transitioning from the current to future state, while addressing the current needs of the stakeholders with successful results.

The MDP is aimed at providing reciprocal learning methods by engaging participants in learning sessions of constructivist tools and interventions, and subsequently by applying them in different MDP sessions for successful immersion.

Introduction to Learning through Cases as a constructivist pedagogy for higher education: Learning through case studies is fundamentally aligned with the constructivist approach to education, as it embodies key principles of active engagement, social interaction, problem-solving, contextual learning, reflection, ownership of learning, and the incorporation of diverse perspectives. In case studies, learners actively construct their understanding by analysing real-world scenarios, engaging in collaborative discussions, solving complex problems, and reflecting on their experiences. This approach places learners at the centre of the learning process, encouraging them to take ownership of their education, make connections between theory and practice, and consider multiple perspectives, all of which are foundational tenets of constructivism in education.

Introduction to the Relevance of Design Thinking in higher education: Design thinking exhibits a distinctly constructivist nature, making it highly relevant in higher education settings. Rooted in the principles of active learning, collaboration, and problem-solving, design thinking aligns with the constructivist philosophy by emphasizing students' active engagement in the learning process. Through iterative cycles of ideation, prototyping, and testing, students construct their understanding of complex problems and develop innovative solutions. The approach encourages social interaction and collaborative teamwork, mirroring the constructivist belief in the importance of social context in knowledge construction. In higher education, where preparing students for the dynamic challenges of the real world is paramount, design thinking equips them with adaptable problem-solving skills, nurtures creativity, and instills a mindset of continuous learning. By immersing students in real-world, context-rich projects, design

thinking fosters an environment where they actively construct knowledge, take ownership of their learning, and develop the critical thinking skills essential for success in today's ever-evolving landscape.

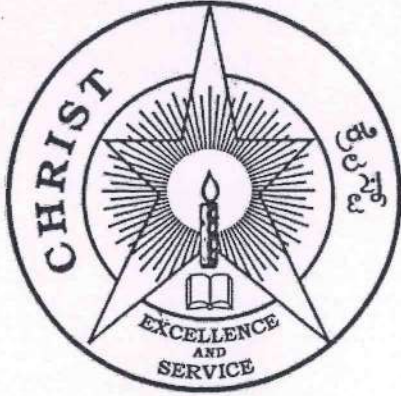

...use of technology has remained unexplored for the teaching industry and community. Technology has come into everyday use, with smartphones, internet connectivity, media-sharing and collaboration tools available to almost everyone across the globe.

...Education Beyond Curriculum (CEDBEC) CHRIST (Deemed to be University) is putting together ... in the field of Screenwriting, eLearning, and filmmaking to provide comprehensive training on creating documentaries as one way of utilising the current technology in teaching. It is our plan to conduct a workshop, where the participants get to understand the creative and technical processes in producing a documentary and Podcasts, another up-and-coming audio-visual medium that is very popular among the next learning generation.

This proposal outlines the background to the workshop and its importance, the target audience, and a proposed training/Workshop agenda for the same

THE UNIVERSITY

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was born out of the educational vision of St Kuriakose Elias Chavara, an educationalist and social reformer of the nineteenth century in South India. He founded the first Catholic Indigenous congregation, Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), in 1831 which administers CHRIST (Deemed to be University).

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was established as 'Christ College' in 1969. It undertook path-breaking initiatives in Indian higher education with the introduction of innovative and modern curricula, insistence on academic discipline, imparting of Holistic Education and adoption of global higher education practices with the support of creative and dedicated staff."

The University Grants Commission (UGC) of India conferred Autonomy to Christ College in 2004 and identified it as an Institution with Potential for Excellence in 2006. In 2008 under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Government of India, declared the institution a Deemed to be University, in the name and style of Christ University. One of the first institutions in India to be accredited in 1998 by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Government of India, and subsequently in 2004, 2016, 2022 CHRIST (Deemed to be University) is currently accredited with 'A+' Grade.

The University is ranked among top 100 universities in India at 67 in the NIRF India Ranking 2023 of Ministry of Education, Government of India. The multi-disciplinary University which focuses on teaching, research and service offers Bachelor, Master and Doctoral programmes in humanities, social sciences, sciences, commerce, management, engineering, architecture, education, and law to about 30000 students.

The University offers its programmes at four campus locations in Bangalore in Karnataka, at Lavasa in Pune in Maharashtra, and Ghaziabad in Delhi NCR. RELEVANCE TO TEACHERS

The pandemic had opened up a wealth of technology for online classes, and had been instrumental in the worldwide adaptation of technology to the classroom, even where there was reluctance or opposition to the use of technology. While teaching has opened up to technology, a large proportion of the teaching process, still uses technology as an adjunct, and not as an integral part of the teaching and learning experience. PowerPoint presentations and smartboards just replace the chalk or whiteboard pen and duster. University and College libraries, if they have adapted, supplement print books with digital copies. There have also been very few attempts to capture and reuse a gifted pedagogue's teaching. Online classrooms including Zoom® MS Teams® and Google Classroom® provide the ability to record classroom sessions. While these provide an opportunity to reuse a classroom session, the sessions themselves are based on the teacher interacting with the students and do not attempt to engage the learner. When a teacher creates a documentary, the process uses the best content expert, the teacher themselves, to structure, design, and create a documentary that best conveys the content in the most engaging and motivating experience for the student. The documentary can then be used by the teacher to provide students with content for self-learning, and thereby use the flipped classroom methodology to enable self-learning, and focus on filling the knowledge gaps during classroom sessions. The teacher can introduce the topic, provide the documentary as a learning material to be viewed by students after classroom time. The teacher follows up by either conducting a quiz and addressing gaps, or inviting the students to raise their queries for clarification. It can also be stored as part of a media library and used by an institution to capture and reuse the best of a teacher's knowledge base and teaching expertise

WHY DOCUMENTARIES?

- Adapting Learning Using Social Media Tech

As learning and teaching have transitioned from book-based, to audio-visual technologies, immersive learning, and finally, to hand-held learning through mobile phones, pedagogical approaches have also been adapted to maximize the use of different technologies and tools to be able to provide students and learners with the best learning experience. While several technologies have become accessible to teaching staff, there are very few training opportunities that enable and empower our teaching community in the knowledge, use, and application of these technological tools. There are several apps, available for both desktop and mobile phones that can be used to create materials including audio-visual content, assessments, information exchange and so on. However, these tools are configured more to the native smartphone user, a species of learner, who is more attuned to the use of smartphones and social media, than even its parent group, the digital natives. The upcoming generation not just tuned to social media, but uses it to influence, learn, and discern ideas. Of all social media content, the most effective and powerful type of content is videos. Businesses use them for a wide variety of purposes, including branding and marketing (Mohsin, M.2023). Studies show that 82% to 92% (Ltd, S. S. 2023), (InVideo, S. F. (2021) of internet traffic is video content, which in raw numbers, translates to 240 exabytes (1 exabyte = 1 billion gigabytes), of which roughly 30% are educational videos. Videos are shared more than other types of content, including images and text. The estimated proportion of video sharing has been established at approximately 1200% (Moroles, J. (n.d.)) compared to other forms of content.

- Documentaries and Academic Results

One important form of videos includes documentaries, which can provide edutainment to learners, providing them with the ability to quickly learn, and share among their peers. Many Edutech and Elearning companies have been quick to monetize video-based education, through the use of various formats such as Whiteboard videos, Expository videos, and Light board videos to push learning content. Learning or Teaching documentary videos present an opportunity to create videos with a difference. A storyline that can be used to emotively engage a learner and provide them with the incentive to complete watching the video. In addition, effectively engaging videos will increase the sharing of the same through social media. Academic research has also established the importance and effectiveness of using documentaries in teaching college-going students (Blum, D., & L Smythe, J. 2021), especially in humanities and social sciences. Documentaries have demonstrably improved learner performance based on pre- screening vs post-screening scores (Sapar et. al 2019) (Gusnissa, et. al 2021). This can be attributed towards the combined audio-visual medium, the storyline and cinematic elements that are used in documentaries, and the learner's sub-conscious assignment and perception of the accuracy and integrity of a narrator. Creating documentaries requires a certain amount of skill and craft, to be able to hold the audience attraction, and provide engagement. The cinematic storytelling aspect of documentary-making is quite easy to achieve. Professional YouTubers and TikTokers have fine-tuned the art of Reflexive documentaries (Aldredge, J. 2022) and the elements of good production value that enable the documentary maker to create professional looking videos are very easy to achieve. With the use of a few basic tools and techniques, teachers can create outstanding documentaries that can be used in the classroom. Further attempts will be made through the workshop to create educational documentaries on the challenge of SDGs as applicable to Higher Education.

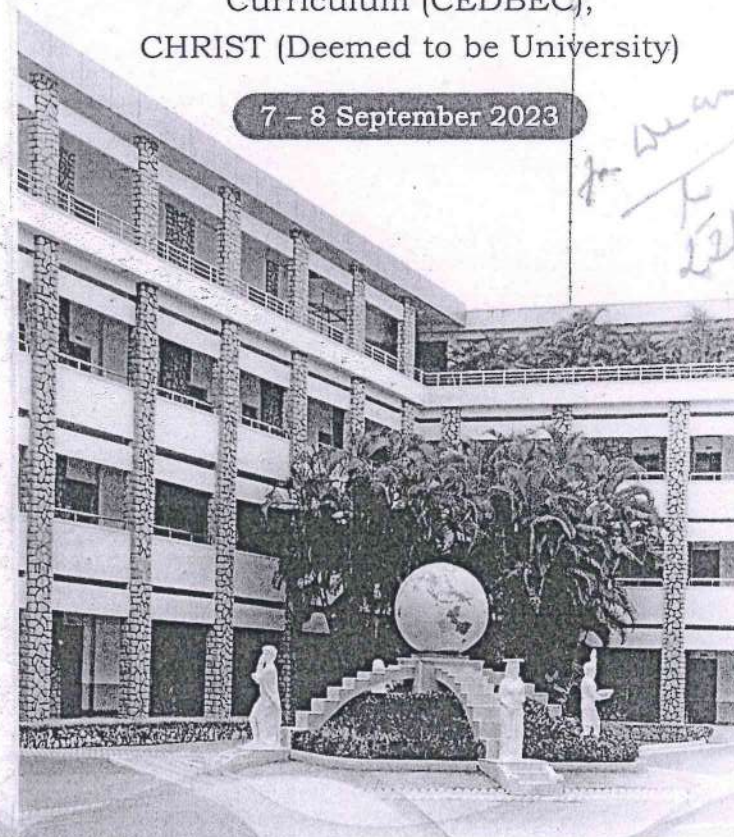




