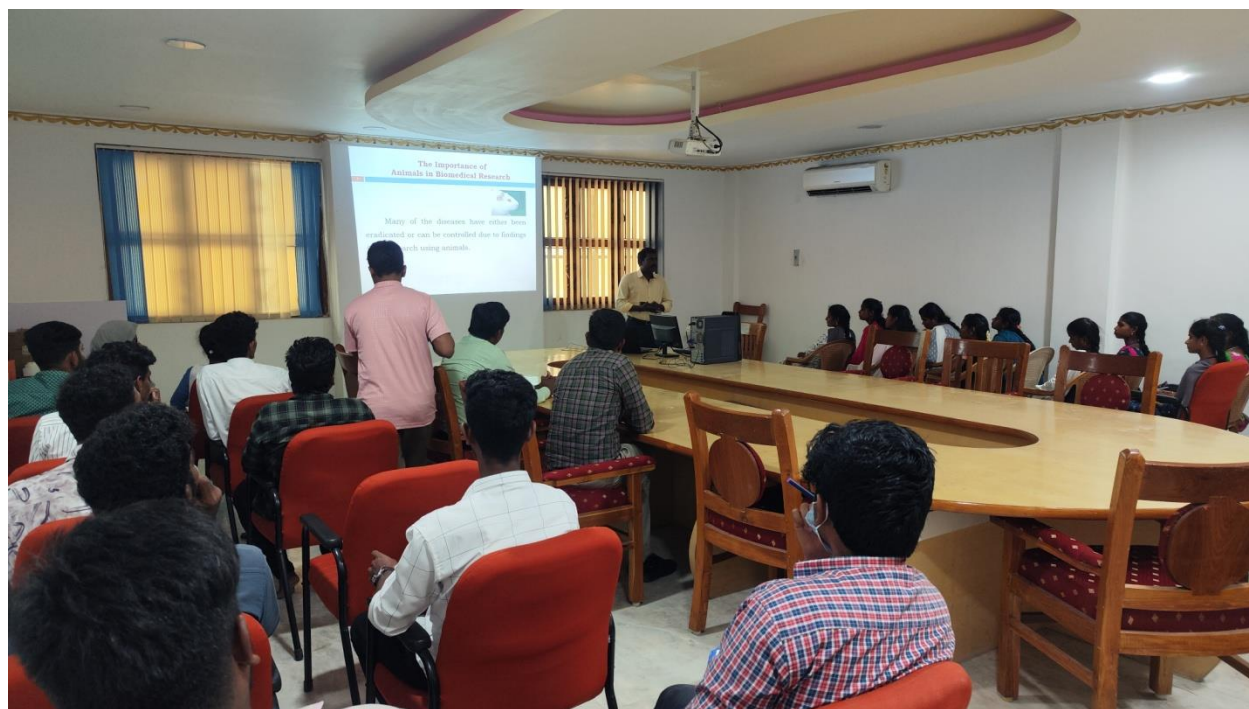
Activity Report
