1. The course objectives are clearly stated, with the majority of students indicating a strong understanding of them.
2. The arrangement of the course content is mostly coherent, although some areas may require further clarification.
3. The relevance of the listed textbooks is acknowledged by most students, with a good balance between high and normal relevance.
4. The overall standard of the syllabus is viewed as adequate, though some students find it somewhat demanding.
5. The content of the syllabus is primarily seen as relevant, though there are a few areas that could be improved.
